11.0 Report of the Superintendent

Superintendent Steven McGhee reported that Harper Woods High School achieved a 100% graduation rate and a 100% college acceptance rate. The Harper Woods High School Track Team won the State Championship. The district maintained its academic status at the high school, and Tyrone Elementary demonstrated improvement at the state level. The Harper Woods High School track is part of the high school and is not open to the public, as there is no liability insurance agreement with the city. Additionally, custodians each morning remove vapes and other drug paraphernalia etc. from the playgrounds at the elementary schools, which poses safety concerns for children. This issue is also occurring at the track. This week someone stole the trailer from the High School.
